5. We respect equally the varied educational lineage and traditional learning of natural earth medicine found within our membership.
6. We treat one another with respect and kindness. We value thoughtfulness and mindfulness. We are supportive of each other's ongoing development.
7. We make decisions aligned with Estuary Learning Values, which are at the core of everything we do.
8. We value connection and accessibility. We maximise accessibility to education and mentoring for our members. We do this regionally and financially.
  - a. Regionally we are accessible through technology or face-to-face learning.
  - b. When possible, we share clinics and workspaces for education and mentoring.
  - c. We are financially within reach of our members and community.

The philosophy of Estuary Learning, its ethics and values are the core significant factors in the consideration of all matters arising within Estuary Learning.

- Notify the Steering Committee of any possible conflict of interest as soon as it is known.

### *Misunderstandings & Disagreements*

Differences of opinion are a natural and welcome part of our community. When disagreements arise, it is the responsibility of all members involved to actively seek a constructive resolution.

Should a dispute occur, it may reflect a lapse in understanding or application of the living principles of Estuary Learning. In such instances, members may refer the matter through our Estuary Learning resolution process.
